

Where to Find a Rich, Single Woman in the United States

Are you a male who is tired of looking for just any old girl? Instead you want to find a single, RICH woman?

If you are a man who is tired of having to “pay the freight” in the dating scene, maybe it is time you head to a part of the country that is “target rich” AND where the targets ARE rich!

Sure, sure, you want a NICE woman, too. (Maybe?) But we figure you can just as easily find the perfect woman from a pool of rich single woman as you can from any other source.

So it is with this in mind that we present the top 10 places in the United States where you can find a rich, single woman.

How We Did the Rankings

But just how do you rank all the places in the U.S.? Well, first we obtained data from the US Census. But then we had to figure out how to take that data and rank the cities in the U.S.. If you want to find people with a lot of money, you can't go wrong by heading to the Hollywood Hills. But with mortgage payments and the cost of living, your money doesn't go quite as far there as it might somewhere else.

Wealth Index

The trick is to find a woman who is wealthy in a place where your money goes a long way. So we factored in a “cost-of-living” adjustment in our rankings. We also looked at more than one measure of income to rank the cities – including median income and number of households in the city with incomes above \$100,000. We combined all of these factors together to come up with a way our wealth rankings.

The Golden Ratio

Money, of course, is not the only thing that is important. And a city having many single female residents also just is not good enough - because if there are a lot of single

males in the area as well, then you are not going to have as much luck. No, what you want is a city that ranks high in terms of the ratio of single women to single men.

So to help you find an area where there are many more single women than men, we calculated the “golden” ratio for each city. This is the ratio of single women (age 25-34) to single men (age 24-34). The higher this ratio, the better! We then ranked the cities from best to worst, and used the rankings in determining which cities are best overall.

We also factored in the percentages of the populations that are single – the larger the percentage of the population that is single, the better that region is for finding single, rich women!

As mentioned earlier, this information is provided to you in part by the US Government. It was all carefully calculated using data from the United States Census. A top market research and analysis company called Teasley (www.teasley.net) conducted the analysis. Another company called GeoLytics (www.geolytics.com) provided the data. The results are found below.

The Top Ten Places in the US to Find a Rich, Single Woman

City #1: Washington DC/Baltimore

US ranking % of population never married – Top 10%

US ranking adjusted median income – Top 10%

Single Female “Golden Ratio” – Top 10%

If you are looking to find a rich, single female, then head to the Washington/Baltimore corridor. Maybe it’s all those rich, successful Capitol Hill lawyer types?

- It’s in the top 10% of cities in the country in terms of the percentage of the population that is single
- It’s in the top 10% of cities in the country in terms of incomes versus cost of living.
- It’s in the top 10% of cities in the country in terms of the ratio of single women to single men.

These factors combine to make it the #1 place in the U.S. to find a single, rich woman!

City #2: New York City

US ranking % of population never married – Top 10%

US ranking adjusted median income – Top 10%

Single Female “Golden Ratio” – (almost) Top 10%

Isn't there a song where the guy sings, “New York, New York, what a wonderful town..?” Maybe now we know why. The New York City area lands a very close second behind Washington DC as the best area to find a single, rich woman.

New York City has a large single population (in the top 10% in the country) and is almost in the top 10% when it comes to the single female to male ratio.

A wonderful town, indeed.

City #3: Boston

US ranking % of population never married – Top 10%

US ranking adjusted median income – Top 10%

Single Female “Golden Ratio” – Top 20%

Many of the students that attend college in Boston end up staying in the area after they graduate. Since there are many schools in and around Boston, the population of the area is relatively young. This translates into a good number of single females in the area. With more MBA-degreed women coming out of the local business schools and more female doctors coming out of Boston University and Harvard – the number of rich single women in the area is high.

City #4: Atlanta

US ranking % of population never married – Top 10%

US ranking adjusted median income – Top 10%

Single Female “Golden Ratio” – Top 20%

“Hotlanta” has a burgeoning singles scene, and a rapidly growing economy, too. The action down on Peachtree Street has never been better for a guy looking to find a single rich female.

Atlanta ranks very high for the size of its single population, and in income versus cost of living. It also ranks high in the ratio of single women to men.

City #5: Chicago (w/ Gary, IN, & Kenosha WI)

US ranking % of population Never Married – Top 10%
US ranking adjusted median income – Top 10%
Single Female “Golden Ratio” – 25th Percentile

The windy city ranks fifth in our survey of where to find a single rich woman. Not only is there a large single population (which all seems to be on Rush Street on New Year’s Eve), but incomes go a long way and it is in the top 25% of all cities in terms of the single female to single male ratio.

City #6: Philadelphia

US ranking % of population never married – Top 20%
US ranking adjusted median income – Top 20%
Single Female Golden Ratio” – Top 10%

Maybe “The City of Brotherly Love” should change its’ moniker to “The City to Love Rich Single Women”? One of the best areas in terms of the ratio of single women to single men, the high rankings in both single population and income make Philadelphia a great place to conduct your quest for a rich, single woman.

#7 Detroit/Ann Arbor

US ranking % of population never married, 25-34 – Top 20%
US ranking adjusted median income – Top 10%
Single Female “Golden Ratio” – (almost) Top 20%

The Detroit/Ann Arbor area of Michigan comes in at #7 in our ranking. It could be a large single population staying in the area after graduation from the University of Michigan. It could be some high power executives in the area that have earned a lot of money combined with the relatively affordable cost of living. Whatever it is, The Detroit/Ann Arbor area is a great area to search for single, rich women.

#8 Raleigh, Durham

US ranking % of population never married – Top 10%

US ranking adjusted median income – Top 10%

Single Female “Golden Ratio” – Top 25%

Wasn't Susan Sarandon single when she was working with the Durham Bulls baseball team in the movie “Bull Durham”? Maybe now we know why Kevin Costner was smiling as the catcher for the team. He was working in one of the best places in the country to find a single rich woman, and he seemed to do all right.

#9 Hartford, CT

US ranking % of population never married,– Top 20%

US ranking adjusted median income – Top 10%

Single Female “Golden Ratio” – Top 25%

Hartford, Connecticut comes in at number nine. The cost of living in the area is low compared to incomes, and there is a large single population and a good ratio of single women to single men.

#10 Milwaukee/Racine, WI

US ranking % of population never married – Top 20%

US ranking adjusted median income – Top 20%

Single Female “Golden Ratio” – Top 20%

Remember Laverne and Shirley? Weren't they single with full time jobs paying union wages? Combine that with the area's relatively low cost of living and you have a good place to search for single rich women.
